4. Yo and pull through the remaining two loops on the hook to complete the single crochet stitch.

Double Crochet Stitch

1. Insert the hook into the second chain stitch from the hook.
2. Yo and pull up a loop onto the hook (two loops on hook).
3. Yo and pull through one loop on the hook (three loops on hook).
4. Yo and pull through two loops on the hook (two loops on hook).
5. Yo and pull through the remaining two loops on the hook to complete the double crochet stitch.

Tips for Left-Handed Crocheters:

- Practice regularly to build muscle memory for the unique movements.

- Use a light-colored yarn to make it easier to see your stitches.
- Take breaks to avoid hand fatigue.

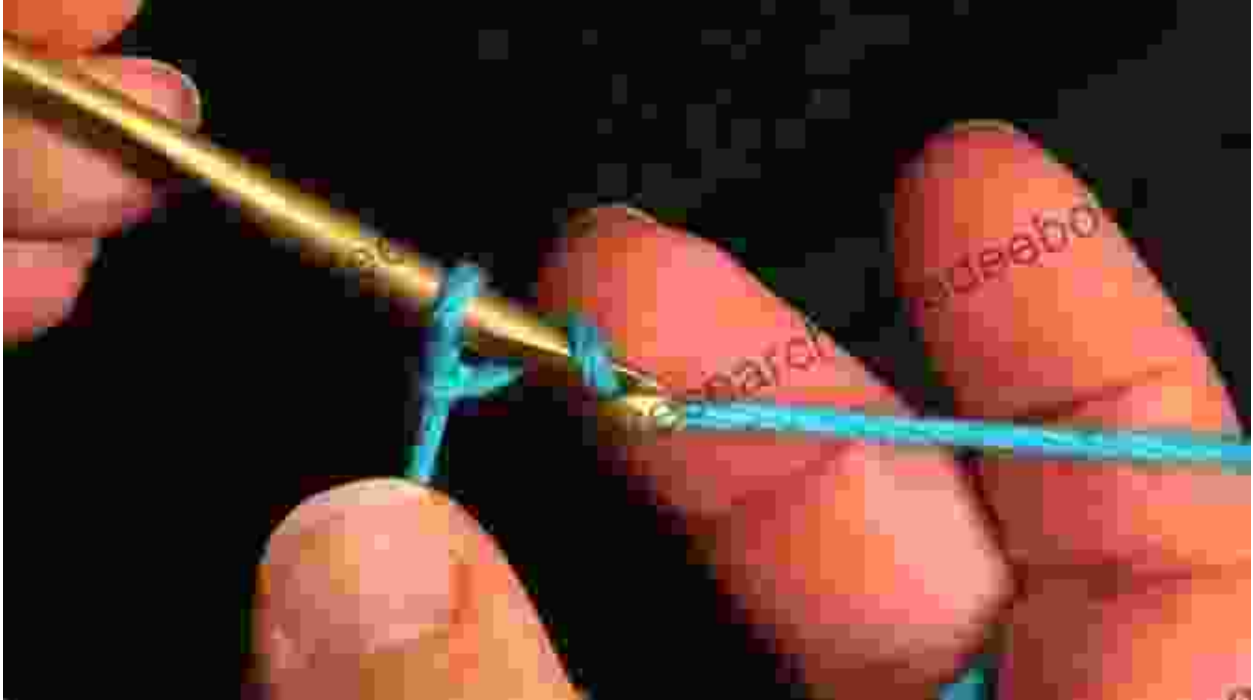

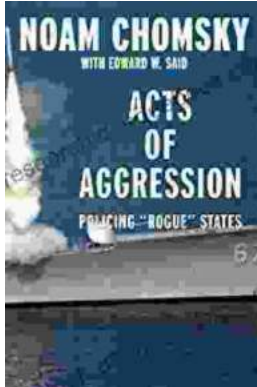
