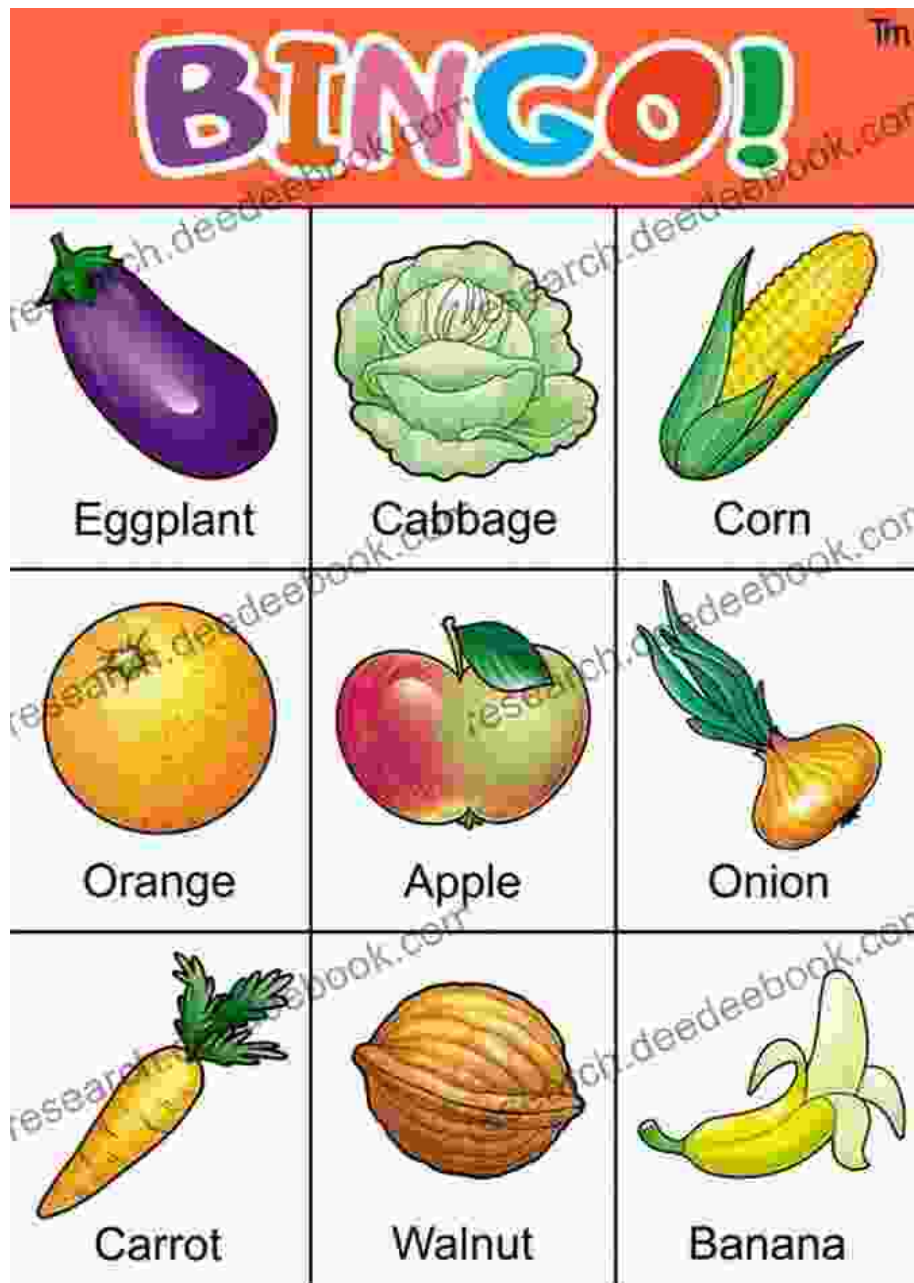
Kindergarten Math Games

- **Pirate Treasure Hunt:** Ahoy, matey! Set up a treasure hunt with clues that involve counting or simple addition. Kids follow the clues to find

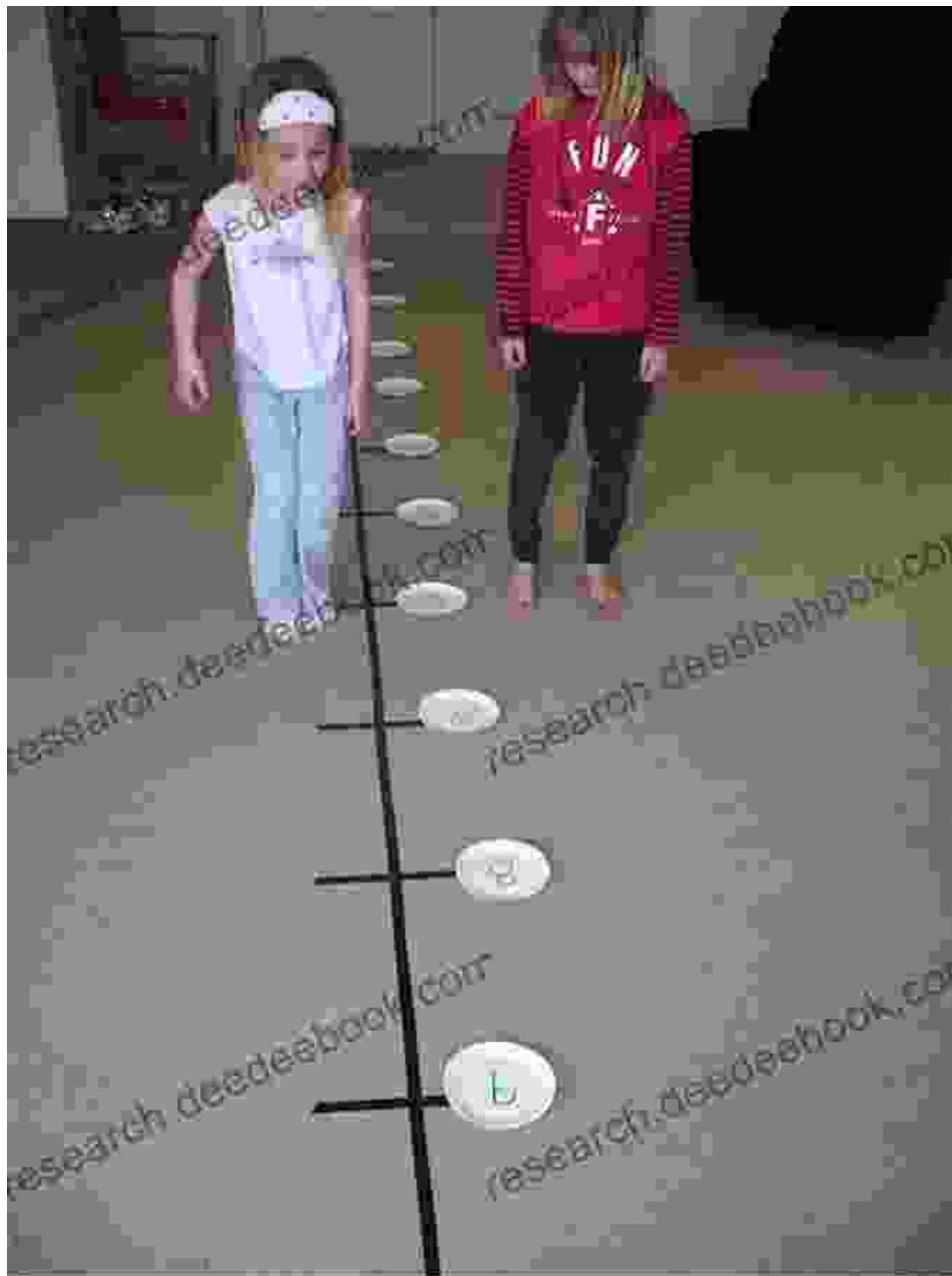
the buried treasure.



Grade 1 Math Games

on. The first to reach 100 wins.



- **Roll and Subtract:** A simple dice game where kids roll dice and subtract the smaller number from the larger one. Encourage them to

use mental math or counters to solve the problems.

Grade 2 Math Games

- **Math Bingo:** Use bingo cards with addition or subtraction problems. Kids solve the problems and mark off matching answers on their cards.



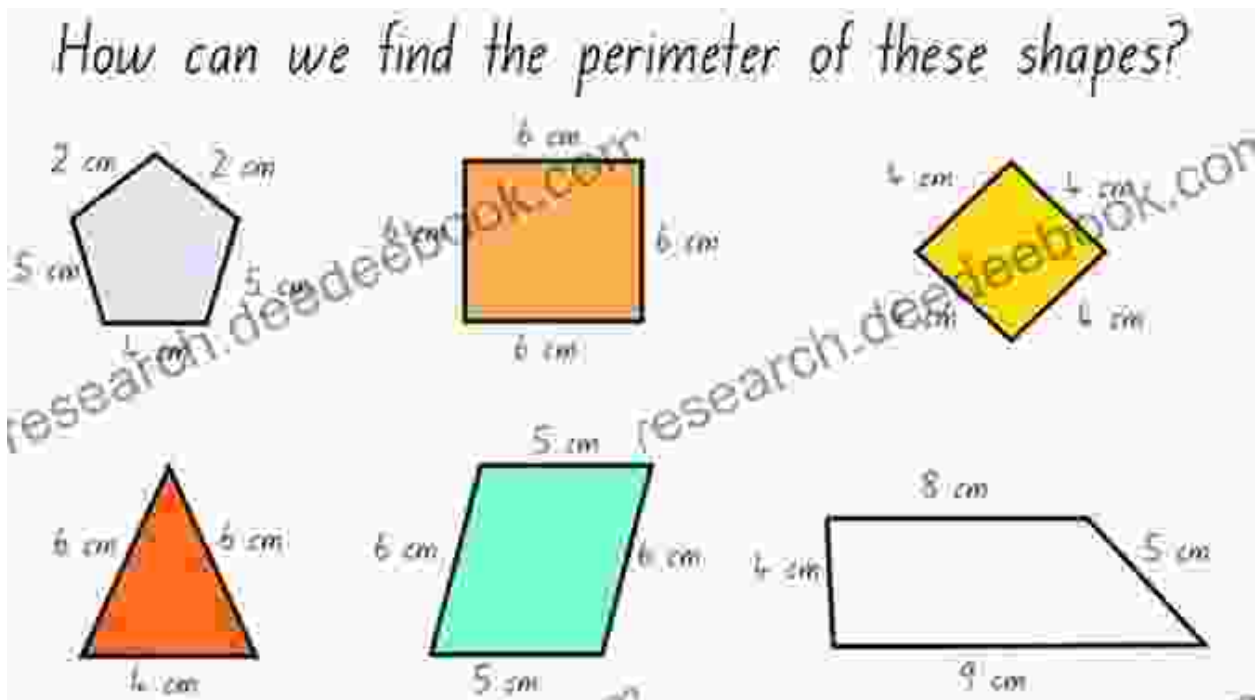
- **Factor Fun:** Introduce the concept of factors with this game. Have kids work in pairs and take turns listing factors of different numbers. The

- **Perimeter Patrol:** Give kids shapes and have them measure and calculate the perimeter. Encourage them to use different strategies and

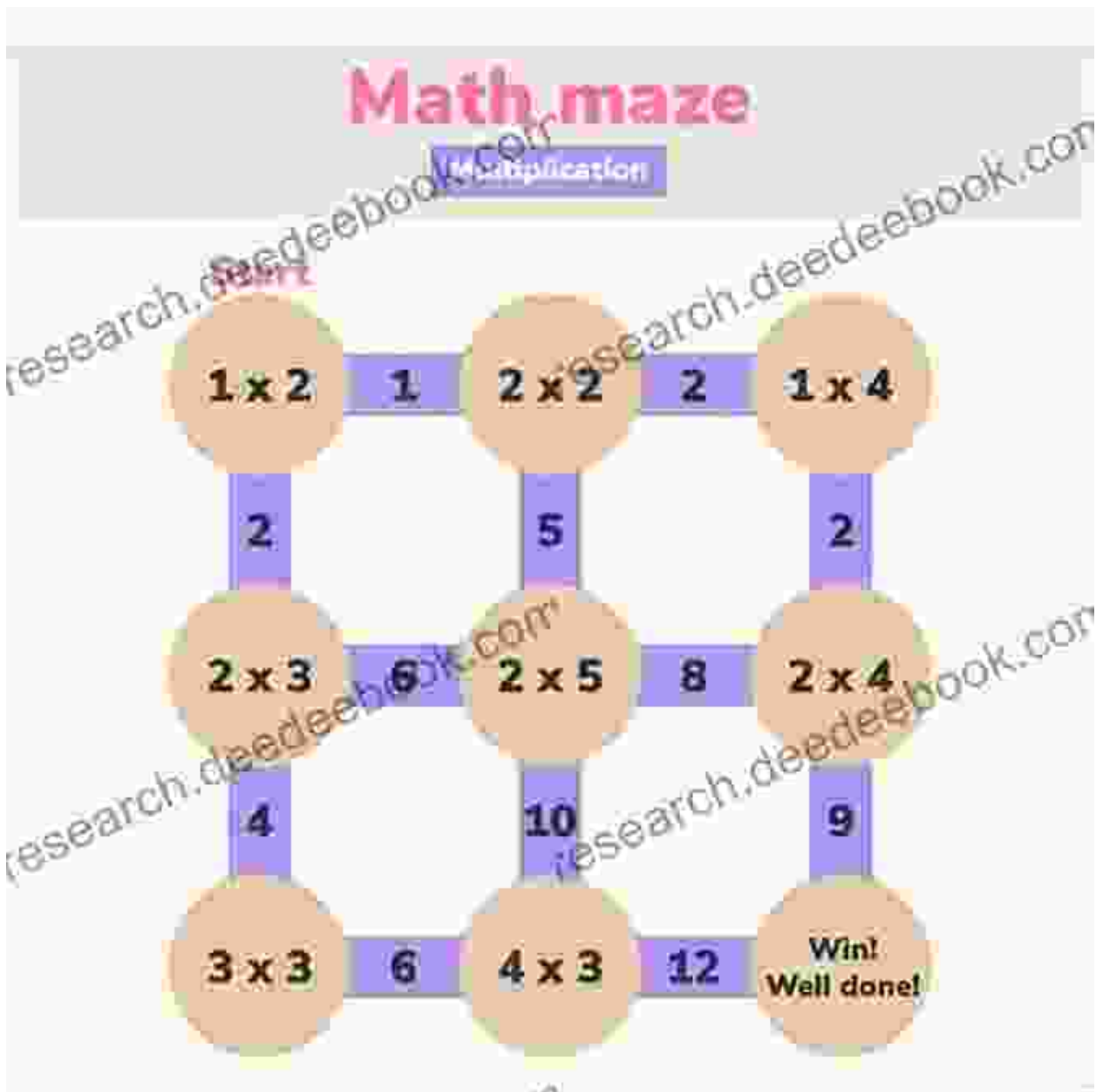
discuss their findings.



Grade 3 Math Games

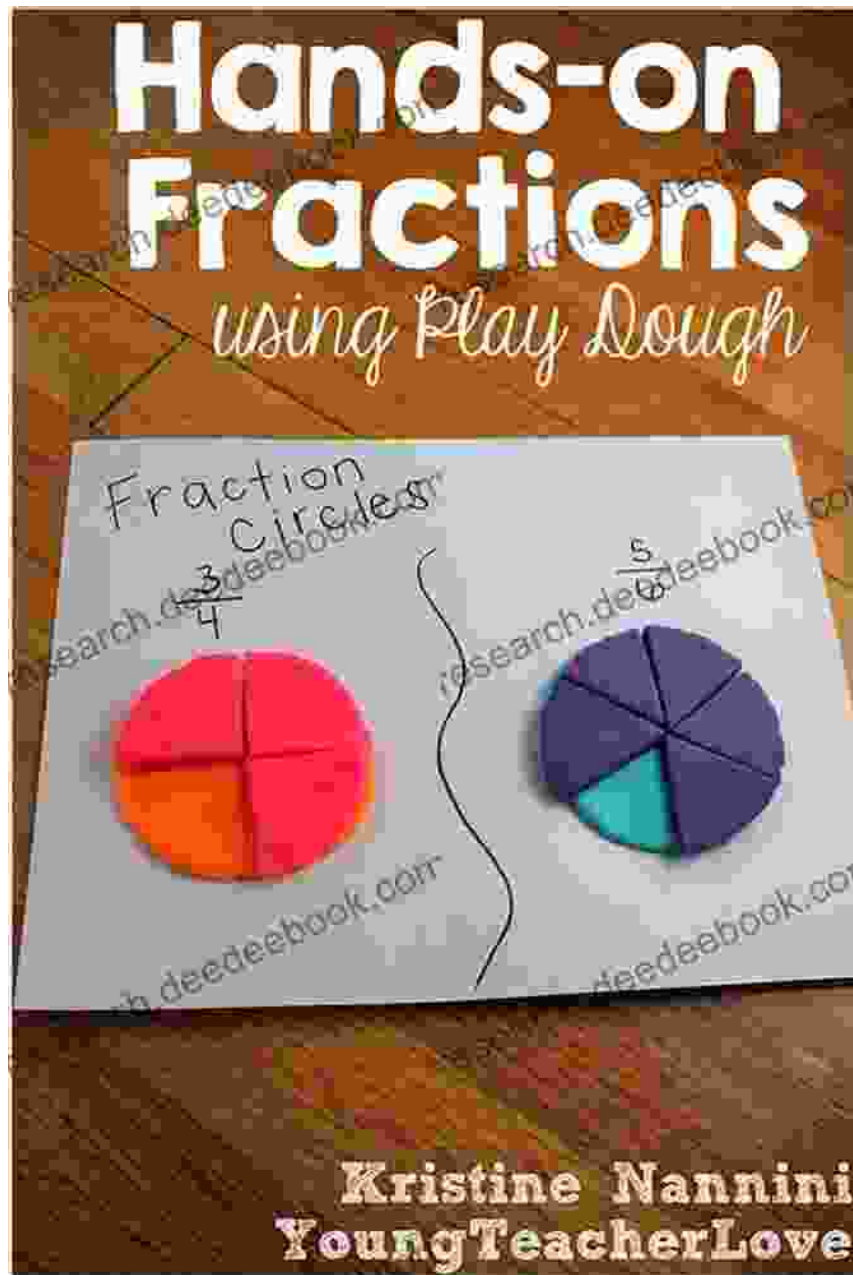
- **Multiplication Maze:** Create a maze on graph paper and fill it with multiplication facts. Kids solve the facts to navigate through the maze

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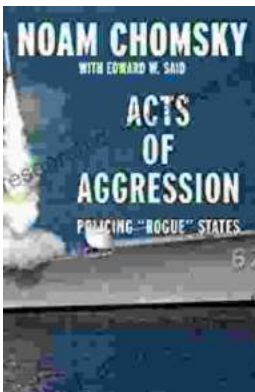
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
