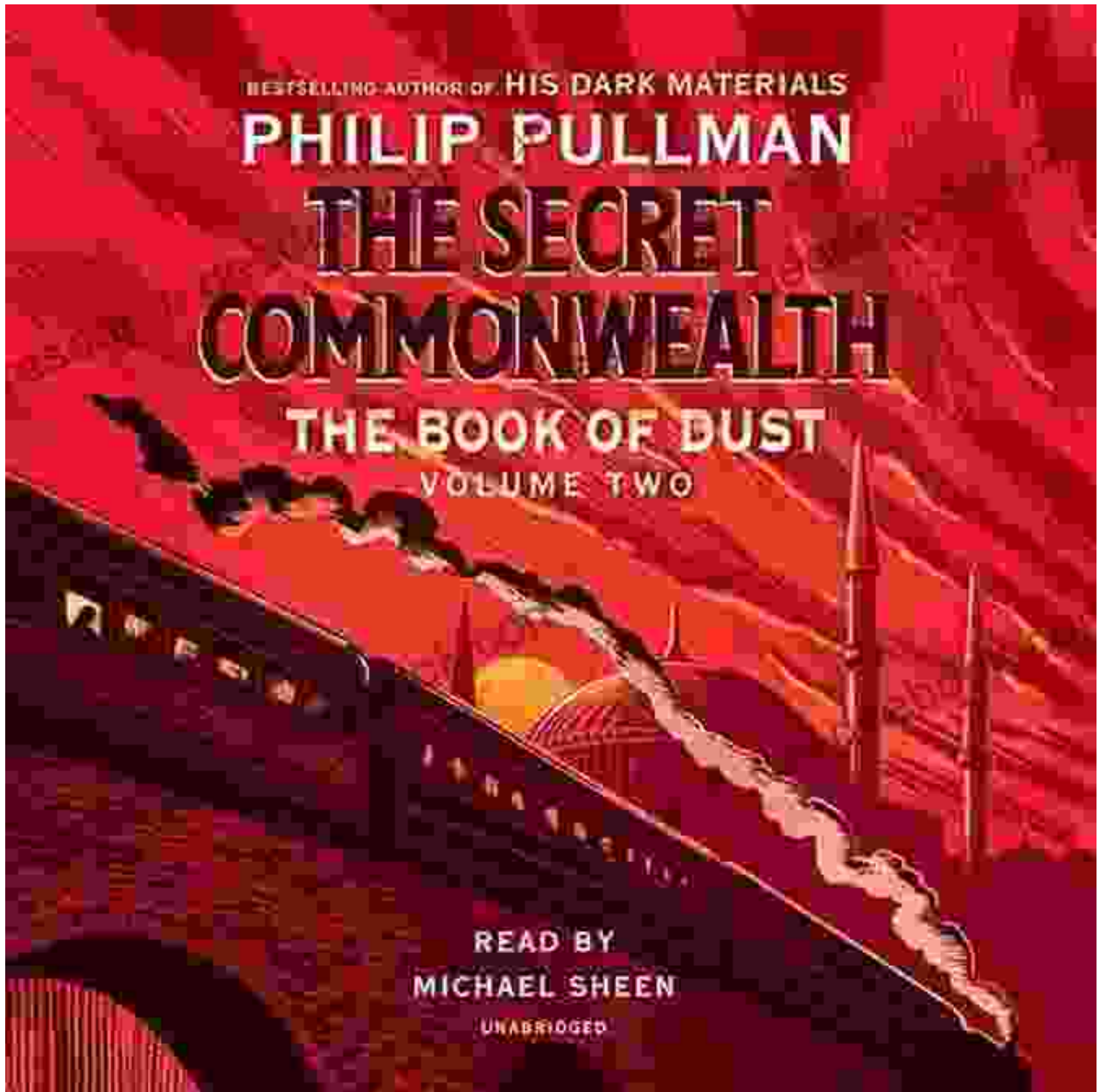
1. **La Belle Sauvage (2017)**

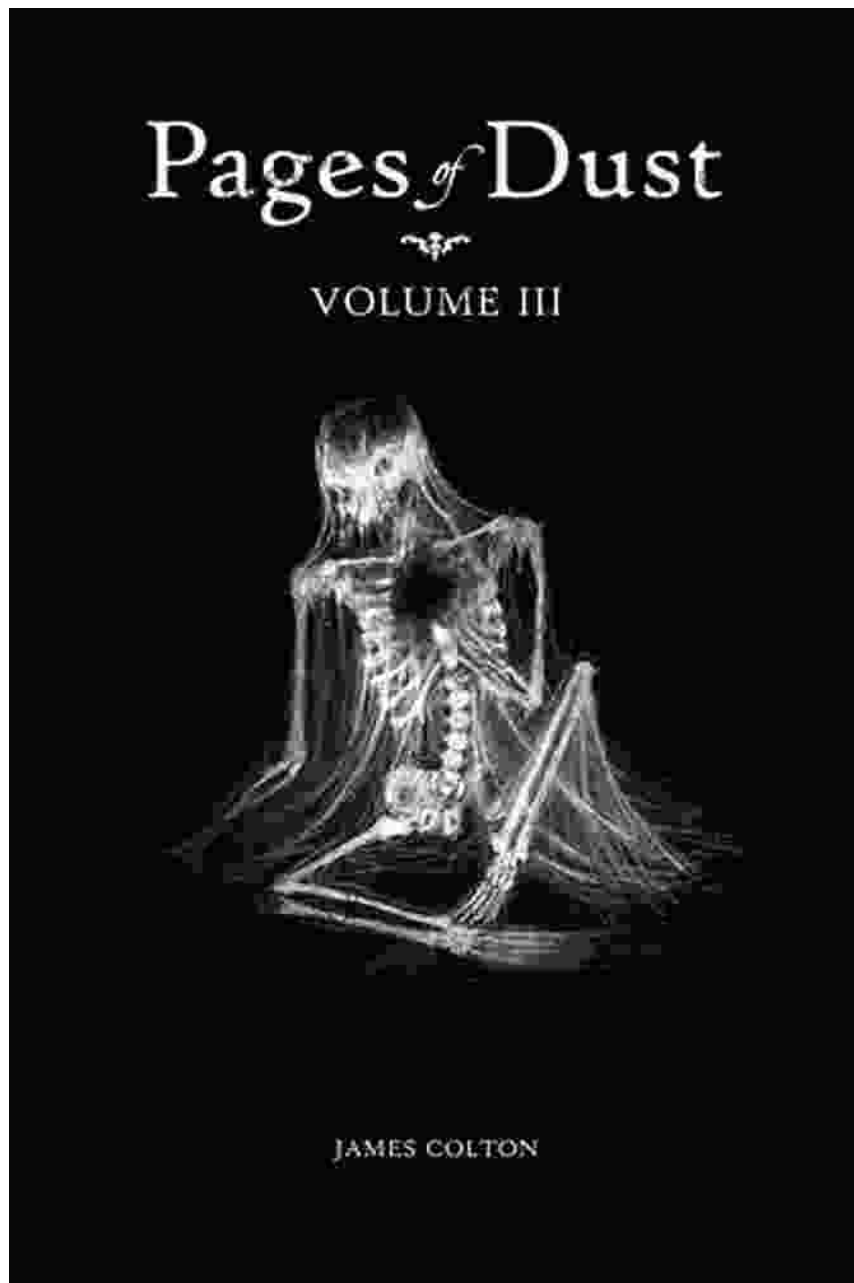

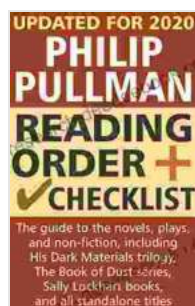

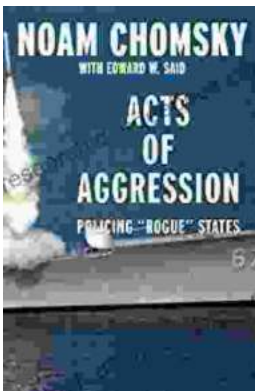
