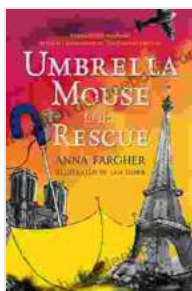


Umbrella Mouse to the Rescue

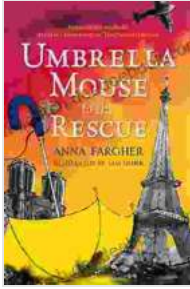

4. What can we learn from Umbrella Mouse's story?



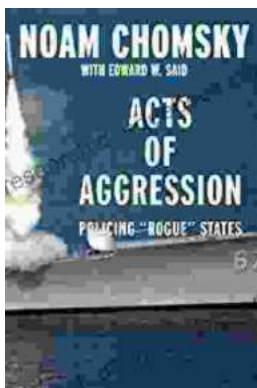
